TIPS FOR APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIPS:

1. Read the eligibility requirements carefully, along with the deadline requirements.
2. Get a brag sheet from the College/Career Center, fill it out and give it to teachers, counselors, or anyone who may be writing a letter of recommendation for you. The earlier the better! Most scholarships require two to three letters.
3. Some scholarships will require an essay or personal statement. Keep several copies for future scholarships.
4. Organize your applications, your parent's financial information (including tax forms), your test scores, transcripts, letters of recommendation, and anything else that is requested.
5. Follow instructions to the letter, and make sure that your application is legible. Proofread your application, or have someone do it for you, and also make copies for your records.
6. The College/Career Center is available to students from 7 AM – 4 PM daily if you need assistance.
